



Points of Pride

- St. Mary offers retreats for every grade level, to help students grow closer to God & one another.
- Class of 2016 performed over 3,500 hours of Christian Service.
- St. Mary begins foreign language education in Kindergarten.
- St. Mary middle and high school student-athletes compete on 32 teams and in 11 sports.
- Graduating class of 2016 had an average ACT score of 23.6, with 45% scoring a 25 or higher. The Kentucky state average is a 20.
- Class of 2016 completed 132 honors courses, 28 AP courses, and 372 college credit hours, earned a collective numeric grade average of 90%.
- 75% of St. Mary students who took AP courses received a score of 3 or higher. This is 23% higher than the state average.
- The average college scholarship offer for the Class of 2016 was approximately \$51,000 per student.
- 100% of the 2016 graduates continued on to post-secondary education.
- St. Mary offers a variety of clubs such as: Academic Teams, Catholic Youth Leaders, Chess Club, Choir/Orchestra, and Lego/Robotics/Science Club.
