Catholic Fact: Did you know Pope Francis urged us to be annoying Catholics?

Several years ago, the Pope said "Today we can ask the Holy Spirit to give us all Apostolic fervor and the grace to be annoying when things are too quiet in the Church . . . and if we annoy people, blessed be the Lord." To be annoying doesn't mean to be obnoxious or insensitive or the evangelical equivalent of a bull in a china shop - those things are easy for most of us. But to be annoying Christians means to be a joyful, peaceful, effective, and utterly confounding witnesses to the Gospel. This requires grace, plus a whole lot of hard work. The pope already told us how to get the grace: implore the Holy Spirit. But what about the hard work? What are some practical ways we can become annoying Catholics? *Be Joyful!* We can radiate the joy you've found in Christ. Smile. Laugh. Be merry. Mystify the world with the unmistakable light beaming through you and have a darned good time doing so. *Be Real!* Learn to be comfortable with your own humanity. Don't invest all your energy in trying to hide your frailties and imperfections from the world. People will learn more from the real you than they will from the fake you. The real you is the one transformed by grace. *Defy Expectations!* Be the interesting, dynamic, well-rounded, whole person God made you to be. Find the good in the culture and celebrate it.
